CHECKLIST FOR A WALK

When going for a walk you need to be prepared. So get out your rucksack and get ready to go!

You will need the following items:

- ⊕ Bottle of Water
- ⊕ Suncream and Hat
- ⊕ Wellies for Stream Walking
- ⊕ Snack
- ⊕ Your clue list and answer sheet

Your adult may also like to bring:

- ⊕ A small first kit
- ⊕ Something for stings or bites
- ⊕ Wet Wipes
- ⊕ Hand sanitizer

Health and Safety notice

As with all activities, there is some risk. The following list is not complete but a guide to some of the risks on the walk:

- ⊕ Bramble cuts or snags
- ⊕ Bee or wasp stings
- ⊕ Nettle rash
- ⊕ Dog poo
- ⊕ Slippery surfaces under foot
- ⊕ Open water and streams
- ⊕ Ticks—are plentiful in long grass. Long sleeves and long trousers are suggested. Please check your child/ren thoroughly of any evidence of ticks after the walk. You will need a pair of tweezers to remove the tick.

Inside you will find six stories with the pictures and plot summary. Each story will be featured in six locations. Look at the map on the inside and find out where each story is going to be?




Map for Storybook Trail

Can you guess which story is which?


Walk Two


Walk Six


Walk One


Walk Five


Walk Three




Map of Story Book Trails




